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Technical Requirements

- 1. Stage table**
 - 1m x 2m; 90 cm high, clean, solid and rigid
 - located in Front of House or Stage area
 - clear visibility on stage, separated from the crowd and potential hazards (spilled liquids, theft, staff passing back and forth, etc.)
- 2. Power Supply**
 - 4x power sockets, 230V
 - perfect working condition (short circuits, torn cables, loose connectors is a big no-no)
- 3. Input - Output signal cables (depending on the event and stage equipment)**
 - HDMI
 - RJ-45 (ethernet) cable for ArtNet connectivity
 - Additional RJ-45 (ethernet) cable for Pioneer Pro DJ Link sync (optional but always more than welcome)
 - DMX

Key points before the show

- **Important! Footage from other performing artists (such as logos, video clips) are to be delivered no later than 1 hour before the show on USB Drive (please refrain from sending links to cloud storage at the last notice)**
- Preferable video format is .mov, full HD resolution or above
- Other file formats are fine as long as I have enough time for conversion and adjustments
- I reserve the right not to use files that are corrupted, in poor resolution, badly exported and glitching
- Technical documentation such as stage layouts, fixture specs, screen resolution, LED Walls specs are to be delivered in advance for preparation and show design
- Please provide contact details to Promoter, Stage Manager and LD prior to the event

Hospitality Requirements

- Access to backstage area and place to store equipment cases, clothing etc.
- Water or other non-alcoholic drinks to be provided at no extra cost to the artist at the venue
- Drink tokens (if available)
- Car parking spot at the venue (if available)
- Event stickers! Always love to collect those :)

Social media

- Please make sure to tag the artist on social media channels in posts, stories and reels.
A separate post or story about the VJ is a big plus, love you big time :)

Let's get real, every event is different and so are the technical aspects and venue capabilities. Which is why I'm open for a discussion and all necessary arrangements. Let's talk everything through in advance, so that we have a smooth, stress-free collaboration and fun in general.
